Update on Countywide Wetlands Protection Code

Local Option Gas Tax

Mayor Surrency- Didn't agree with County decision regarding the Gas Tax. This decision will cost the City of Hawthorne \$10K per year for the next 5 years. We are asking the County to revisit and consider consumption and where the majority of the money comes from. The Discussion continued.
